***** **Very Important Please Read Completely** *****

Please ask any questions

It is crucial that all dancers arrive on time. Please allow extra time for unforeseen issues such as traffic and weather delays. **Dancers are to come in nude leotard and tights with their hair and makeup show ready.** If you have questions please ask in advance, we are here to help. Prior to leaving home, **double check that you have all costumes, costume pieces with you including proper shoes and tights and that everything is labeled with your child's name. Remember no jewelry or nail polish.** Please feed your child prior to arriving at the theater, there can be no eating or drinking (other than water) once in costume. We encourage you to pack a water & clean snack (pretzels) for them to eat after they have performed. Please consider any additional items you send as **we cannot be responsible for lost items.** (Example: iPods, iPads, Cell Phones)

Drop-Off Procedures for Act I students: Parents please follow the signs to the green room (South side of the theater) and report to the check in table. You will then leave your child (unless you are a volunteer) with the volunteers that will be overseeing your child's class. ONLY Pre-Ballet parents may enter to help child put costume on. We ask that all parents then enter the theater through the lobby doors which will open one hour prior to show-time and take their seats. We are unable to have any adults other than those who have registered as volunteers remain backstage. Your child will remain in the dressing rooms, other than their dance time(s) and final bows, until their dismissal. Students only in ACT 1 must be picked up at intermission. We will not be able to dismiss students before Intermission. You may take them into the audience to watch ACT 2 with a purchased ticket.

Drop-Off Procedures for Act 2 ONLY students: Parents please follow signs to the green room (South side of the theater) and report to the check in table to drop off any students that are only in Act II for the appropriate show day. Please go DIRECTLY to this door and drop them off as soon as Intermission begins. Intermission is about 1 hour into the show. Students only in Act 2 should sit in the audience and watch Act 1. They must have a ticket to sit in audience. Students may not wear their costume in the audience.

*Dads in the Daddy/Daughter dance: After "This is Me" make your way to the Green Rooms use left side for Entrance *

Pick-Up Procedures:

Tiny Tea Cups, Cream Puffs, Cotton Candy, Sugar Cubes, Baby Belles, Cup Cakes, Fancy Feather, Little Lumieres, Mimes, Duster, Flower girls, Flower Garden, Peppermint Patty, will be dismissed at intermission **in the listed order.** These students MUST be picked up at intermission at the double doors INSIDE of the lobby. (Unless they have a dance in Act 2 & should go into the audience to watch Act 2 (not in costume) with a purchased ticket.

All Dismissed students will be picked up from the Green Room at end of the show – At the doors INSIDE of the Lobby.

*Please stay in the "lines" set for parents picking up.

ALL-Company Parents enter through the North rear backstage door to your child's dressing room, on Friday night check all costumes and on Saturday collect all items and child then exit through the same door.

All other parents will be picking their children up at the green room. After the show we ask that **one** parent returns to the green room (From the Lobby) for a pick up. For safety reasons, students will be dismissed by class.

NO parents will be allowed in the green room during dismissal other than volunteers. We'll try to dismiss the students as smoothly and quickly as possible. We appreciate your cooperation & patience.
